## ANNEX TO CERTIFICATE OF AIRWORTHINESS

THIS ANNEX IS ISSUED AS PART OF THE CERTIFICATE OF AIRWORTHINESS IDENTIFIED BELOW AND MUST BE ATTACHED TO THAT CERTIFICATE AT ALL TIMES.

Certificate of Airworthiness Number ATA/8279-X01 is subject to the following conditions: **Operating Limitations:** 

- 1. The aircraft is to be operated within the limitations expressed in the ATEC v.o.s flight manual for the Faeta 321 LSA as amended and the operating limitations contained in CAR 262APA
- 2. Maintenance of the aircraft must be in accordance with the approved maintenance schedule for the the ATEC v.o.s Faeta 321 specified in the ATEC v.o.s Flight and maintenance manual, Rev1.0 initial issue 19<sup>th</sup> October 2005 and later approved revisions.
- 3. This aircraft is to be operated by day under **Visual Flight Rules only**.
- 4. This aircraft may only be operated for the purpose specified at 4 of the Special Certificate of Airworthiness number ATA/8279-X01 dated 14<sup>th</sup> March 2013
- 5. If the aircraft no longer complies with one or more of these conditions, the CofA becomes void. Continued operation with an invalid CofA is a criminal offence. It is permissible, however, for the registration holder of a non-compliant aircraft to apply for an Experimental Certificate.
- 6. Hours flown and maintenance carried out on the aircraft shall be recorded on a "
